The festival programme has added atmospheric pop artist Lafawndah, playful rapper Gianni Mae, electronic composer 6zm, multidisciplinary performance artist and dj Sanni Est, and Maque Tumai and Bad Puppy from The Culonizers, a spaceship - art collective and community network of LatinX Queers, Non Binary and Trans People (+Alliens). Following the talk, there will be a live ritual performance by House of Living Colors members GodXXX Noirphiles, ÁZA, Night Child, accompanied by organist Rahel Hutter.

Next up is our Halloween party at Bi Nuu, which will be jammed packed with live performances from **Tami T**, **Shygirl**, **Gianni Mae**, and **6zm**, followed by an energetic dj set by **Black Cracker**. This event will be a celebration of the local community as well as the many individuals and groups who sustain Berlin's radical artistic character. It will be free of charge with RSVP (link).

On Friday, November 1st, DICE will present an electroacoustic soundscape by Turkish composer **Ipek Gorgun** at the Taborkirche. **The Neighbourhood Character** will regal us with a pre-show dj set to create the atmosphere. Later that night, we will host an all-star lineup at Bi Nuu, including live performances by **Nadah El Shazly** with her band, **Lafawndah**, **Ami Dang**, **Ale Hop** and DJ Sets by **DJ Marcelle/Another Nice Mess** and **Lady Blacktronika**.

On the evening of Saturday November 3rd, DICE presents a multidisciplinary performance by **Crystallmess** entitled "**Collective Amnesia**: **In Memory of Logobi**". Later at Bi Nuu, we will host a series of energetic and genre-spanning live performances by **Dai Burger**, **Golin**, and **RahRah Gabor**, followed by DJ sets by **Crystallmess**, **Tayhana**, and **Q-Bra**.
